

## Acetate Pressing Procedure

In order to make one copy of a record, from your original material, you can do so by making an acetate pressing, otherwise known as a "dub-plate". This is a one-off master record that is essentially a metal plate coated with an acetate spray, then cut on a lathe in the studio. An acetate can last a long time with proper care and usage. acetates take about 1 week to complete.

send a master with the songs you would like cut to an acetate.

include payment and shipping amount in certified funds. This is cash, money order or cashiers check.

include instructions for which format 10" or 12"

include instructions on what tracks to put on what side of the record.

Include your return address.
